

JW Greve

Dr JW Greve, studied medicine at the Catholic University of Leuven, Belgium. His surgical residency was at the Maastricht University the Netherlands. In 1990 he started his career in bariatric surgery. He was co-founder of the Benelux Association for Bariatric Surgery (1995) and of the Dutch Society for Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery (2010). He is past president of IFSO (2006) and served as Executive Director of IFSO. He was co-organizer of the World congress of IFSO in Bruges, Belgium and organizer of the 2005 world congress of IFSO in Maastricht, the Netherlands. He was supervisor of 15 PhD thesis of which 8 on morbid obesity related topics. He was principal investigator of the European Endobarrier trial and participant in the European trial on the Easyband and the POSE.

Dr JW Greve is author of more than 195 peer reviewed papers and is associate editor of Obesity Surgery.

He currently is gastrointestinal and bariatric surgeon at the Zuyderland Medical Center, is chair of the bariatric and metabolic surgery program and medical director of the Dutch Obesity Clinics South
